I am directed to say that Government after careful consideration of the application of Managiri Development Trust, Jaypore, Dist: Koraput and the proposal furnished in your letter No. 11994 dt. 2.8.2000, have been pleased to accord their concurrence for opening of B.Pharm Course in the Jaypore College of Pharmacy, Jaypore, Koraput with an intake capacity of 60 (sixty) students per annum from the academic session 2001-2002 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions.

- (i) The management of the institution will be governed by the instructions of Government of Orissa/Director of Medical Education & Training, Orissa from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall obtain approval of A.I.C.T.E. & P.C.I. before taking up admission of students to the course from time to time.
- (iii) Necessary affiliation of the concerned university should be obtained by the institution.
- (iv) The concurrence is also subject to full compliance with the scheme formulated by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. (C) No. 607 of 1992 Unnikrishnan J.P. & Others - Vrs - State of A.P. & Others and related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the State Government/A.I.C.T.E. & P.C.I./Central Govt./U.G.C. from time to time.

The institution is further informed that Government will not take the liabilities of employment in respect of the pass out students.


Sir/Madam,

val in favour of the institution for opening of D.Pharma Course.


You are, therefore, requested to consider the applica-


